**REGIONAL DISTRICT OF OKANAGAN-SIMILKAMEEN**

**BYLAW NO. 2190, 2003**

---

A bylaw to establish solid waste and recyclable materials collection and drop-off services in parts of the Regional District of Okanagan-Similkameen.<sup>1</sup>

---

**WHEREAS** the Board of Directors for the Regional District of Okanagan-Similkameen (the “Regional District”) may establish a service for solid waste and recyclable materials collection and drop-off services in parts of the Regional District;<sup>2</sup>

**AND WHEREAS** the Board of Directors for the Regional District considers it expedient to establish a service for solid waste and recyclable materials collection and drop-off services in parts of the Regional District;<sup>3</sup>

**NOW THEREFORE** the Board of Directors for the Regional District, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

**1. ESTABLISHMENT OF THE SERVICE**

(1) Solid waste and recyclable materials collection and drop-off services are established as the Solid Waste Collection and Drop-Off Service (the “service”).<sup>4</sup>

(2) The Board may operate the service in the Solid Waste Collection and Drop-off Service Area described in this bylaw (the “service area”) and, without limitation, enter into a contract with a third party to implement the service.<sup>5</sup>

**2. SERVICE AREA**<sup>6</sup>

The service area contains the whole of the Village of Keremeos and Electoral Areas “A”, “B” and “G” and the parts of Electoral Areas “C”, “D”, “E”, and “F” respectively outlined in heavy black border on Schedules “A”, “B”, “C” and “D” attached to and forming part of this bylaw.

**3. PARTICIPATING AREAS**<sup>7</sup>

The Village of Keremeos and Electoral Areas “A”, “B”, “C”, “D”, “E”, “F”, and “G” include participating areas for the service.<sup>8</sup>

**4. METHODS OF COST RECOVERY**<sup>9</sup>

The annual costs of the service shall be received pursuant to Sections 803(1)(a) and (c) of the Local Government Act as follows:

(1) By the requisition of money in the service area, to be collected by a property value tax on the net taxable value of improvements alone within the service area, to be levied and collected in accordance with division 4.3 or Part 24 of the Local Government Act.

(2) By the imposition of fees or other charges that may be fixed by separate bylaw for the purpose of recovering those costs..

(3) By a combination of (a) and (b) above.

**5. APPORTIONMENT<sup>10</sup>**

The annual costs of the service shall be apportioned amongst the participating areas in the service on the basis of the actual costs of providing the service in each participating area..

**6. LIMIT<sup>11</sup>**

The maximum amount that may be requisitioned under Sections 805 and 806 of the Local Government Act for the service is \$1,250,000.00.

**7. REPEAL**

Bylaw No. 2105, 2001 is repealed.

**8. CITATION<sup>12</sup>**

This bylaw may be cited as the "Solid Waste Collection and Drop-Off Service Establishment Bylaw No. 2190, 2003".
