## REGIONAL DISTRICT OF OKANAGAN-SIMILKAMEEN

### BYLAW NO. 2328, 2009

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A bylaw to authorize the use of the Municipal Ticket System.

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**WHEREAS** pursuant to Section 264 and 265 of the *Community Charter*, the Regional Board of the Regional District of Okanagan-Similkameen may, by bylaw;

- (a) designate those bylaws which may be enforced by means of a form of ticket prescribed by regulation,
- (b) designate bylaw enforcement officers for the purpose of enforcing bylaws by means of a prescribed form of ticket.
- (c) designate an offence against a bylaw by means of a word or expression on a ticket; and,
- (d) set fines not greater than the amount prescribed by regulation.

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Board of the Regional District of Okanagan-Similkameen in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

#### **Section 1 - Citation**

- 1.1 This Bylaw shall be cited as the Municipal Ticket Information Bylaw No. 2328, 2009.

#### **Section 2 - Repeal**

- 2.1 Municipal Ticket Information System Bylaw 1950, 1999 and amendments thereto are hereby repealed.

#### **Section 3 - Enforcement**

- 3.1 The bylaws, which shall include any amendments thereto, as listed in Column 1 of Schedule 1 to this bylaw may be enforced by means of a ticket in the form prescribed for the purpose of Section 264 of the *Community Charter*.
- 3.2 Persons acting as any of the following are designated as Bylaw Enforcement Officers for the purposes of this Bylaw and the *Community Charter*:
- a) Special constables, officers, members or constables of the provincial police force as defined in Section 1 of the *Police Act*, R.S.B.C. 1996, c. 367 (the "*Police Act*"), as amended from time to time;

- b) Bylaw Enforcement Officers appointed pursuant to section 36 of the *Police Act* and section 264(b) of the *Community Charter*, S.B.C. 2003, c. 26, as amended from time to time;
- c) Members of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police;
- d) Regional District of Okanagan-Similkameen corporate officers;
- e) Local Assistants to the Fire Commissioner appointed under Section 6 of the *Fire Services Act*, R.S.B.C. 1996, c. 144, as amended from time to time;
- f) Bylaw Enforcement Officers, Building Officials, or other persons appointed by the Regional District Board of Directors for the purpose of the enforcement of one or more of its Bylaws.<sup>1</sup>

3.3 The amounts appearing in Column 3 of the Schedules to this bylaw are the fines set pursuant to Sections 265(1) of the *Community Charter* for the corresponding offences designated in Column 1.<sup>2</sup>
