## Questions You May Have

### When do I require a dog licence and what are the fees?

All dogs require a licence on the 1st of January . Current fees:

1. Intact Males & Non-Spayed Females \$50.00
2. Spayed Females, Neutered Males \$20.00
3. Replacement Tag \$5.00

### Does my dog need to wear the licence?

Yes. Your dog must wear the licence on it's collar or harness at all times [unless kept in a pen or enclosure on the owner's property]. The tag allows the Animal Control Officer to contact you.

### Should I have my dog on a leash?

Yes. Your dog should be on a leash for its own safety. The bylaw requires that all dogs must be under the control of a competent person when off their owner's property.

### When a dog defecates is the owner required to remove the feces?

Yes. Owners are required to promptly remove and dispose of the feces . Be a responsible owner and clean up after your dog!

### What if my dog has been impounded?

Your dog will be released after purchasing a tag and after payment of the impoundment fee, maintenance fees and any associated fines. Dogs not claimed within 72 hours may be humanely euthanized, sold or adopted. If an owner can't be found, every effort is made to find new homes through the adoption process.

### Are there fines imposed?

Yes. Fines can be imposed at the discretion of the Animal Control Officer. They can be disputed within 14 days. If you have lodged a complaint and the investigation results in a fine, you may be required to provide evidence at a Hearing, either in person or over the phone, if the ticket is disputed by the dog's owner.

### Who do I call about a barking dog?

Barking dogs fall under the Noise Control Bylaw in areas "C", "D", "E", "F", "H", and "I" only. You may contact South Okanagan Security at 250-492-0911 **when it is barking**. It is a good idea to keep records of times and dates of when the dog is barking for the Officer's information.

### Impoundment Fees :

- 1st impoundment \$50.00
- 2nd impoundment \$100.00
- 3rd impoundment \$250.00
- Additional impoundments \$500.00
- Maintenance Fees \$20.00
