PURPOSE: to change the land use designations in order to allow for the construction of a secondary suite on a parcel that is less than the permitted 2020 m<sup>2</sup> in area.

Amendment Bylaw No. 2451.22, 2018, proposes to amend Schedule '2' of the Electoral Area "A" Zoning Bylaw No. 2451, 2008 by changing the zoning designation from Residential Single Family (RS1) to Residential Single Family Site Specific (RS1s).
