1) it does look from the plan that this addition could be undertaken if backed up to maintain the allowable distance off the street. The request for 3.75 meters leaves minimal parking opportunities in an already crowded cul de sac. Parking is at a premium as it is given the logistics of a cul de sac, and Kent Place is no exception, already cluttered with boats, travel trailers, utility trailers and living out of town, most families have two vehicles as well, therefore we are not in favour of granting this variant request.
