## **Purpose of Bylaw:**

The purpose of this amendment bylaw is to amend the zoning is to change the zoning of the parcel at 4865 North Naramata Road, Naramata (That part of DL286 shown on Plan B1364, SDYD, Except Plans 29967 and A11020) from Agriculture One (AG1) to Agriculture One site Specific (AG1s).

The rezoning, if approved, to allow development of once accessory building up to 210 m<sup>2</sup> in area.
