## CONDITIONS

- 1. Permit may be cancelled if variations are made to the submitted plans and specifications without prior approval from Interior Health.
- 2. Permit is not renewable or transferable and expires one year from the date of issuance.
- 3. Significant changes to the estimated sewerage flow rates must be authorized by an Environmental Health Officer.
- 4. Permit does not cover electrical workings. Retain a qualified electrician to ensure electrical workings meet appropriate code.
- 5. The owner must follow the approved maintenance plan.
- 8. All sewerage must be disposed of at an approved waste management facility. Retain all disposal receipts.
- 7. A valid contract with a sewerage "pump and hauler" is required at all times the holding tank is being used.
