

PUBLIC HEARING Electoral Area "G" Official Community Plan Bylaw No. 2975

The RDOS is proposing that an Official Community Plan (OCP) Bylaw be enacted for Electoral Area "G". The OCP reflects the priority of the residents in the community while including policies of the Regional District Board with regards to land use and development.

The bylaw received 1st and 2nd readings by the Regional Board on August 4, 2022 and had a public hearing in the communities of Keremeos and Hedley on August 23, 2022. The public hearing was recessed and is being reconvened as follows:

Time:	7:00 p.m. (Q/A period from 6:00 – 7:00 p.m.)
Location:	702 - 4th Street, Keremeos

Anyone who believes that their interest is affected by the Electoral Area "G" Official Community Plan Bylaw No. 2975, 2022, will be given the opportunity to be heard or to present written submissions respecting matters contained in the proposed bylaw at the public hearing.

The project team and Area Director will be available for an hour before the public hearing for a Question/Answer period. You are encouraged to ask any questions you may have during the Q/A period as the public hearing is an opportunity to *only* provide comments regarding the contents of the OCP bylaw and not to ask questions.

You can provide written comments to the Regional District by e-mailing planning@rdos.bc.ca *prior to the close of the public hearing* may also speak at the public hearing. No letter, report or representation from the public will be received after the conclusion of the public hearing.


