

## Comparison Table – “Tourist Cabins” (General Regulations)

Current Zoning Bylaw No. 2498, 2012	Proposed Zoning Bylaw No. 3065, 2024
<p><b>Tourist Cabins</b></p> <p>The following regulations apply to tourist cabins where permitted as a use in this Bylaw:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. A tourist cabin shall:<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>a) have a floor area of less than 50 m<sup>2</sup>;</li><li>b) have a door direct to the outdoors;</li><li>c) have a maximum of one sleeping unit; and</li><li>d) be located on a parcel 1.0 ha or larger in area.</li></ol></li></ol>	<p>[see Note]</p>

NOTE: In Zoning Bylaw No. 2498, 2012, the regulations for “Tourist Cabins” is found at Section 7.26. In Draft Zoning Bylaw No. 3065, it is proposed to carry these regulations forward into a new Section 7.5 (“Campgrounds”).
