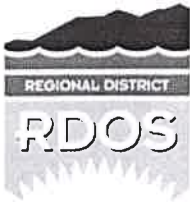
I'm writing to express my disapproval of dvp 12025.001. I own [REDACTED] and I do not want building any closer than the current allowed setback.
