Purpose of Bylaw:

The purpose of Amendment Bylaw No. 2862, 2020, Regional District of Okanagan-Similkameen Okanagan Basin Lakes Official Community Plan and Zoning Amendments is to maintain opportunities on the major lakes in the Valley for community and visitor use, while also helping protect environmental qualities of the lakes and existing community infrastructure such as water intakes.

The proposed policies and zoning regulations apply to all aspects of Okanagan, Osoyoos, Skaha, and Vaseux Lakes and their foreshores within the RDOS's jurisdiction of Electoral Areas "A", "C", "D", "E", "F", and "I").
