

## BOIL WATER NOTICE OKANAGAN FALLS WATER SYSTEM LOWER ZONE ONLY

February 26, 2025

The Regional District of Okanagan-Similkameen (RDOS) is issuing a **Boil Water Notice** effective immediately for the Lower Zone on the Okanagan Falls water system (see links below and/or page 2 for Lower Zone description). This notice is in response to a water line break this afternoon that has resulted in an emergency shutdown of a portion of the Lower Zone. Crews are onsite, however, there is no estimated time for service renewal at this time. This **Boil Water Notice** will remain in effect until further notice.

Residents are advised to use a safe alternate water source or to boil water for all drinking, brushing teeth, food preparation/cooking purposes, and ice making. Water should be brought to a full boil and allowed to boil for at least one (1) minute.

Residents are reminded to use a safe alternate source of water for preparing baby formula for infants and young children during this time due to the potential for elevated manganese levels resulting from the disruption of sediments in the water mains.

Residents may observe some discolouration or sediment in the water. If you experience dirty water, simply run your cold water taps only and/or garden hose until the water runs clear. Residents may also wish to isolate their in-home treatment systems until turbidity has decreased to normal levels. In addition, residents should check the water quality before laundering clothing during this time to minimize potential staining or discolouration.

The RDOS would also like to remind all business owners/operators (bed and breakfasts) and public facilities operators that it is the responsibility of these establishments to notify your customers of the **Boil Water Notice.** 


