The steel shed has been in place for many years and we were fine with it, as it was on his property. Then in 2023 I registered a complaint about the fact that he was adding onto the building, as well as knocking down our fence. We hired a lawyer and had it replaced, not well but it's up.

In June 2023 we had a survey done of our property as he seemed to want to encroach. There was a stake placed inside the fence at the back, by his shed. The stake was at least 2 feet inside the fence, which he immediately took out. I believe that is the reason for the second variance.

The owner of 204 has since lined our fence with dead tree branches and an old truck chaise with the gas tank attached.
