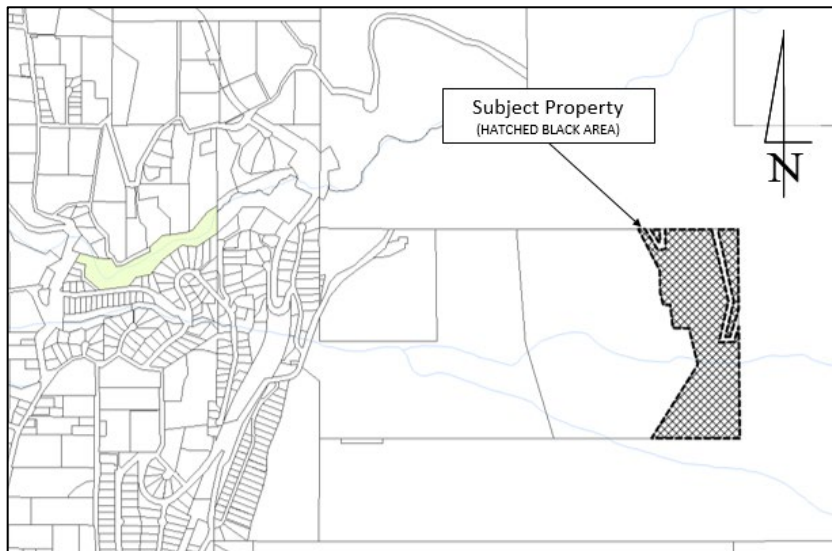

Zoning Amendment Bylaw

The amendment is being sought in order to increase the maximum allowable length of stay within a campground from 30 days to 182 days.

Amendment Bylaw No. 2800.19, 2022, proposes a textual amendment to the existing Resource Area Site Specific (RAs) zoning under the Okanagan Valley Zoning Bylaw No. 2800, 2022, which applies to the property in order to include an additional site specific provision to allow for a maximum length of stay within a campground of 182 days.
