RE: Public Hearing Report - Amendment Bylaw No. 2461.14, 2020

Purpose of Bylaws:

The proposed amendments to the Electoral Area "F" Zoning Bylaw No. 2461.14, 2020, are to change the zoning designation of a 3.3 hectare portion of the property at 8025 Princeton-Summerland Road from Small Holdings Three (SH3) to Site Specific Small Holdings Two (SH2s). The bylaw also proposes to introduce a site-specific regulation to increase the maximum floor area permitted for a home industry from 200 m² to 300 m².
