

## Comparison Table – “Exterior Lighting” (General Regulations)

Current Zoning Bylaw No. 2498, 2012	Proposed Zoning Bylaw No. 3065, 2024
<b>Exterior Lighting</b> Exterior floodlighting or spotlighting shall be deflected away from adjacent properties, as well as deflected away from the road to prevent glare for the traveling public.	[Not applicable]

NOTE: In Zoning Bylaw No. 2498, 2012, the regulations for “Exterior Lighting” is found at Section 7.8. It is not proposed to carry these regulations forward into Draft Zoning Bylaw No. 3065, on the basis that this is a nuisance regulation and not a zoning regulation and is more appropriately comprised within a “Good Neighbour Bylaw”.
