GENERAL CONDITIONS

- 1. This Temporary Use Permit is issued subject to compliance with all of the bylaws of the Regional District of Okanagan-Similkameen applicable thereto, except as specifically varied or supplemented by this Permit.
- 2. The land described shall be developed strictly in accordance with the terms and conditions of this Permit, and any plans and specifications attached to this Permit which shall form a part thereof.
- 3. Where there is a conflict between the text of the permit and permit drawings or figures, the drawings or figures shall govern the matter.
- 4. This Temporary Use Permit is not a Building Permit.

APPLICABILITY

5. This Temporary Use Permit applies to, and only to, those lands, including any and all buildings, structures and other development thereon, within the Regional District as shown on Schedules 'A', and 'B' and described below:

TEMPORARY USE

6. In accordance with Section 23.0 of the Electoral Area "I" Official Community Plan Bylaw No. 2683, 2016, the land specified in Section 5 may be used for a "tourist accomodation" use as defined in the Okanagan Valley Zoning Bylaw, being the use of a building or buildings providing temporary accommodation for the travelling public, such as tourist cabins, lodges, motels, hotels, inns, or hostels, which may include common public facilities, such as an

eating and drinking establishment, gift shop; personal services, or spa; but shall exclude vacation rental, recreational vehicles, park model trailers or mobile homes;.

CONDITIONS OF TEMPORARY USE

- 7. The tourist accomodation use of the land is subject to the following conditions:
 - a) The tourist accommodation use shall be limited to the use of two (2) cabins providing temporary accommodation for the travelling public.
 - b) The tourist accommodation use shall not include motels, hotels, inns or hostels.
 - c) The tourist accommodation use shall not include common public facilities, such as an eating and drinking estblishment, gift shop, personal services or spa.
