**RE:** Okanagan Valley Zoning Bylaw Amendment – Regulation of Metal Storage Containers

## **Administrative Recommendation:**

THAT Bylaw No. 2895, 2020, a bylaw to amend the Okanagan Valley Zoning Bylaw to introduce zoning regulations governing the use and placement of metal storage containers, be adopted; and,

THAT Bylaw No. 2805.01, 2021, a bylaw to amend the Building Bylaw to delete the requirement to obtain a "Siting Permit" for placing a storage container, be adopted.

## **Background:**

October 15<sup>th</sup>, 2020 –1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> reading of Amendment Bylaw No. 2895, 2020.

**November 19, 2020 & December 15, 2020** – Public hearings were held and attended by ten members of the public, and seven members of the public and five directors, respectively.

**July 8, 2021** - 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> reading of Amendment Bylaw No. 2805.01, 2021.

May 5, 2022 — repeal and re-read second reading of Amendment Bylaw No. 2895, 2020 and the holding of a public hearing was delegated to Chair Pendergraft.

May 30, 2022 – A public hearing was held and attended by five members of the public and three directors, including Chair Pendergraft.

June 16, 2022 –3<sup>rd</sup> reading of Amendment Bylaw Nos. 2895, 2020 and 2805.01, 2021.

June 21, 2022 – Approval from the Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure (MoTI) is obtained due to the proposed amendments involve lands within 800 metres of a controlled access highway (i.e. Highway 97 & 3).

## Alternative:

1. THAT first, second and third readings of the Regional District of Okanagan-Similkameen Metal Storage Container Regulations Zoning Amendment Bylaw No. 2895, 2020 and Bylaw No. 2805, 2021 be rescinded and the bylaws abandoned.
